**Jeff Harris, Newark City Council President** - Good evening, Council. My name is Jeff Harris, 24 Monroe Avenue. Washington Street is down on the east end. It's been asked from several people from the Shiloh Baptist Church to rename that to Dr. Charles Noble Sr. Street. Dr. Noble built the church down there in 1968. He built, you know, the Washington Square Apartments and all that down there. So, he's done a lot for that community and for our city and for that end of town. So that's what we're asking to do.

**Mr. Houser** - I'll just say something really quick. I appreciate Mr. Harris, you putting that legislation together with the Law Director. I think it documents some of his great accomplishments in the community very well, so I appreciate you doing that.

President Harris - Apartments, yeah.
