Water Administrator Mr. Roger Loomis – There are two of these for \$75k each. This is for some work that we are planning to do for the front of our water office. It's similar to things being done in City Hall for COVID protections for our employees. We have a lot of people that come into our water office and we have a set up in place for safety, but this is a more permanent solution. It's for COVID protection but also for some security issues for protection of the employees. Half of this is coming out of Water funds and half out of Sewer funds, we're going to talk about that contract in Service Committee next. We're hoping to keep it under \$150k, but that just has some extra in there for contingencies so we won't have to come back again.

Water Administrator Mr. Roger Loomis – This is related to the Horn's Hill Sewer installment. This is part of the assessment amount and the amount of the agreement we have with the Trout Club. This is what we will be paying off of that and when the assessments are paid the money will come back to the Sewer Fund. The rest of the money for that project will be a note that we will

pay off over 5 years. That's what the Auditor Steve Johnson and I have worked out. You will be seeing some legislatio	າ on that in the
next few weeks.
