1. **Resolution No. 18-26** authorizing and directing the Mayor of the City of Newark to apply for funding from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance under the bulletproof vest partnership grant program was considered.

**Barbara Gilkes**- this is our annual application to fund vests for the Police Department, Arson Investigators and Probation.
