- 1. **Resolution No. 14-36** appropriating monies for the current expenses of the municipal corporation was considered.
 - a) A request for an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 671, Landfill Reclamation Fund, in the amount of \$250,000.00 (Note Payment)

Steve Johnson, City Auditor- this \$250,000 is needed to pay off a \$250,000.00 note that we are renewing in May. So basically we have two options we can pay it off completely or we can renew it, re-borrow it and that is what this will do. b) A request for an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 422, Debt Service Fund, in the amount of \$3,739.58 (Interest Payment on Note)

 - a) A request for an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 100, General Fund, in the amount of \$3200.00 (Bldg Grounds Maintenance)

Director Rhodes- the first thing that I would ask you to do is disappropriate this \$3200.00 from my budget that is used to pay property taxes out of. We have filed with the County Auditor several pieces of property that will be tax exempt so we will be seeing some savings there. We want to use those savings to pay for some poles that we are putting up at Babe Ruth. They will support some nets to catch fly balls that come down and prevent them from hitting someone.

d) an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 334, Construction Note 3.2 Mil Fund, in the amount of \$15,000.00 (City Hall Rear Parking Lot project needs)

Director Rhodes- we are taking this money off of a construction note that has already been executed for the back parking lot. We are going to be putting some gates on the back parking lot. We have a significant parking problem here at City Hall where people pull in and park in people's parking spots and then we have to find them.

Mr. Rath- I was just wondering how gates are going to resolve that issue, if you were going to post somebody at the gate?

Director Rhodes- no, everybody who has a parking spot there will have an opener like a garage door. All members of Council will get one too for your parking space. When we built the parking garage and parking deck we anticipated this and went ahead and ran the electric for it.

Motion passed by a vote of 5-0.

3. Consider **Resolution No. 14-38** authorizing and directing the Mayor of the City of Newark to prepare and submit applications to the Ohio Governor's Office of Criminal Justice Services for fiscal year 2014 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance grant funding.

Barbara Gilkes- we will be applying to the State for most likely additional communications equipment. This is a 75-25 grant distribution however in the past several years we have been able to get the local match waived.
