1. **Resolution No. 18-39** appropriating monies for the current expenses of the municipal corporation was considered. Expedite

Section 1. There is hereby an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 335, Capital Improvement Fund, in the amount of \$52,000.00 (Cedar Hill Cemetery Project)

Barbara Gilkes- this appropriation is to help with the Cedar Hill Cemetery road project. Tomorrow the Board of Control is hopefully going to award the contract for this project. The bulk of the funding is coming from the Department of Community Development through its' CDBG program but we also need the \$52,000.00 from Capital Improvements to complete the resurfacing of the roads at the cemetery. The project will be completed by August 31st.
