 Discussion item: Consider Resolution No. 20-95 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF LEGAL REPRESENTATION OF INDIGENT PERSONS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2021 WITH THE LICKING COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE CITY OF NEWARK, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Law Director Doug Sassen – This is a standard piece of legislation that we do every year that allows the state to reimburse the city through the county for funds we expend for legal representation of indigent defendants. It's a standard thing we do every year and I know you will recall that we do this generally as an emergency and in this case by Rule 11 and as an emergency because we can't take our action until the state provides their documentation to the county and then the county provides their documentation to us and that puts us up against a bind with the calendar, so we find ourselves tonight addressing this under Rule 11. Simply because of the calendar, but it truly is a ministerial function.
