



It's a nice neighborhood and I have three lots there myself and I don't see where there can be anyplace for children to play except in the neighbors yards. I don't know if it's going to add to the value of the property or degrade the value of the property. I have no idea. I own the property, my son lives on it and he has kids and they play in

their yard and if you have multiple families there with no yards to play in, what're the kids going to do? So, I'm against it.

Upon consideration of the information presented, the following actions are recommended:

1. 

I don't know if it's going to add to the value of the property or degrade the value of the property. I have no idea. I own the property, my son lives on it and he has kids and they play in

their yard and if you have multiple families there with no yards to play in, what're the kids going to do? So, I'm against it.

Upon consideration of the information presented, the following actions are recommended:

1. The zoning classification for the parcel at 440 Ridge Ave Lot 3976 shall be changed to TFR – Two-Family Residence District and the requested zoning district change is recommended to be amended as such. Ordinance 22-03 is recommended to be amended to reflect TFR- Two –Family Residence before passage and approval by Council.


