Whereas, the National Highway Administration and the Federal Highway Administration of the U.S. Department of Transportation provide federal funding for the costs of local law enforcement initiatives designed to improve highway safety; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Newark was notified by the Ohio Department of Public Safety that the City is eligible to submit applications for Fiscal Year 2024 State and Community Highway Funds; and,

WHEREAS, each unit of local government receiving funds must establish special revenue funds into which all payment received by the unit of local government under the Programs are deposited, and it is necessary to establish special revenue accounts for that purpose; and,

WHEREAS, this matter was considered by the Finance Committee of this Council who passed this Ordinance on to the full Council for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1: This Council authorizes and directs the Mayor, or his representative to prepare applications to the Ohio Department of Public Safety Office of the Governor's Highway Safety Representative, for funding assistance through the Highway Safety Grant Programs: STEP and IDEP to make in connection therewith, all certifications, understandings, and assurances, contained therein.

Section 2: In furtherance of the directives established herein, the Mayor is authorized to take whatever action is legally available to attain such funding in the best interest of the City and its participation in available highway safety funding programs.

Section 3: The Mayor is designated as the authorizing official to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Public Safety Office of the Governor's Highway Safety Representative, to administer the grant programs and to accept said funds when they become available.

Section 4: There are hereby established a special revenue funds to be know as the Highway Safety Grant Program funds. The Auditor is authorized and directed to deposit all receipts from the Highway Safety Grant Programs into these funds. Monies deposited into the funds are to be used solely for the purpose of improving highway safety.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PARK NATIONAL BANK FOR THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF TWO (2) NON-TRANSPORT MEDIC UNITS FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE.

WHEREAS, the Newark Division of Fire within the Department of Public Safety is responsible for preserving peace and protecting the citizens of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Fire requires specialized equipment to provide such protective services; and

WHEREAS, a specially outfitted non-transport medic unit is one such piece of specialized equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Newark Division of Fire is requesting two (2) specially outfitted non-transport medic units be purchased utilizing the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program (State Term) as allowed under Resolution Number 87-22; and

WHEREAS, under such program bidding is waived as the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services has entered into contract for the benefit of the state and local municipalities under ORC 125.04; and

WHEREAS, Park National Bank has been identified as a source of funding for lease-purchase of the two (2) non-transport medic units; and

WHEREAS, this matter was addressed in Service Committee on May 1, 2023, which recommended consideration of the same by full Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a lease-purchase agreement with Park National Bank for lease-purchase of two (2) specially outfitted non-transport medic units utilizing the Ohio

Cooperative Purchasing Program as allowed under Resolution Number 87-22, thereby waiving any competitive bidding requirements.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest time permitted by Article 4.07 of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio.
