A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE FOR THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO, TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH PARK NATIONAL BANK FOR THE LEASE-PURCHASE OF ONE (1) MEDIC UNIT FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND DELARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Newark Division of Fire within the Department of Public Safety is responsible for providing fire protection and emergency medical services to the citizens of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Fire requires specialized equipment to provide such fire protection and emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, a medic unit is one such piece of specialized equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Newark Fire Division is requesting that one (1) medic units be purchased utilizing the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program (State Term) as allowed under Resolution Number 87-22; and

WHEREAS, under such program bidding is waived as the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services has entered into contract for the benefit of the state and local municipalities under ORC 125.04; and

WHEREAS, Park National Bank has been identified as a source of funding for leasepurchase of the medic unit; and

WHEREAS, the source of funding has been identified as available through Capital Improvement for purchase via lease-purchase agreement with Park National Bank.

WHEREAS, this legislation went before Council under Rule 11 with the consent of both the Majority and Minority Leader and is declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or welfare due to deadlines related to funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE: The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a lease agreement with Park National Bank for lease-purchase of one (1) new medic unit utilizing the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program as allowed under Resolution Number 87-22 thereby waiving any competitive bidding requirement.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY, GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS 170 OBANNON AVENUE, CITY OF NEWARK, LICKING COUNTY, OHIO, PARCEL TAX ID #054-198390-00.000 AND PARCEL TAX ID#054-198396-00.000, FROM THAT OF LC LIMITED COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO LI LIMITED INDUSTRIAL ZONING DISTRICT, ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO.

WHEREAS, an application for zoning classification has been filed with Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 4.12 of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio, this ordinance shall be referred to the Planning Commission immediately after its first reading; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission shall hold a public hearing upon such application and the Clerk of Council shall cause notice of such hearing to be publicized one time at least seven (7) days prior to the date of such public hearing; and

WHEREAS, upon the return of the ordinance to Council by the Planning Commission, council shall cause a second reading to be made of this ordinance and shall take such action as is appropriate pursuant to Article 4.12 of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The zoning map as established by Ordinance 08-33 (A) is hereby revised by changing the zoning classification for the following described property from LC LIMITED COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO LI LIMITED INDUSTRIAL ZONING DISTRICT, ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO.

SEE EXHIBIT "A" FOR LEGAL DESCRIPTION

Section 2: Pursuant to Article 4.12(C) of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio, a vote of at least six (6) members shall be necessary to adopt or defeat the ordinance in the event the Planning Commission has recommended approval or has made no recommendation. An affirmative vote of at least seven (7) Council members shall be necessary to adopt a zoning ordinance that the Planning Commission has recommended against approval.

Section 3: The Newark Planning Commission is hereby authorized and directed to make the change described herein on the aforementioned zoning map.

Section 4: This ordinance shall become effective at the earliest time permitted by Section 4.07 of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 163 authorizes a public agency to appropriate property or a portion thereof for public use; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Chapter 719 authorizes a municipal corporation to appropriate property for bridges, aqueducts, viaducts, and approaches thereto; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 719.04 requires the legislative authority of a municipal corporation when it is deemed necessary to appropriate property to pass a resolution declaring such intent, defining the purpose of the appropriation, and setting forth a property description of the land and the estate or interest desired to be appropriated; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 719.05 only requires one reading of the Resolution required by Ohio Revised Code Section 719.04; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 719.05 further requires the Mayor, upon passage of the Resolution to cause written notice to be given to the owner or agent of, person in possession of or person having an interest of record in, every piece of property sought to be appropriated, or if such owner, person, or agent cannot be found, notice shall be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipal corporation; and,

WHEREAS, this Council recognizes the necessity for replacement of the deficient bridge on Riverside Drive, over Log Pond Run; and,

WHEREAS, this Council also recognizes the necessity for the appropriation of the Right of Way described as in Exhibit A attached hereto for the purposes of replacement of the deficient bridge on Riverside Drive, last known owner of such property being The Capitol Corporation, successor to North Fork Realty, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Newark, Ohio, to commence appropriation of the real estate described in Exhibit A; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:




