We wish to report :

Mr. Marmie - First just to keep everybody up to date, the General Fund unappropriated balance is at \$124,264.00 and the Budget Stabilization Fund stands at \$1,057,736.00.

 Ordinance No. 22-45 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE NEWARK CITY SAFETY DIRECTOR TO CERTIFY TO THE LICKING COUNTY AUDITOR, THE SUM OF \$440,515.00 INCURRED BY THE NEWARK CITY PROPERTY MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT WITH RESPECT TO PROPERTY MAINTAINENCE VIOLATIONS TO BE PLACED AS A LIEN UPON CERTAIN PARCELS OF REAL PROPERTY SITUATED IN THE CITY OF NEWARK, OHIO. Tim Hickman. Safety Director - This is the annual lien document for unpaid Property Maintenance fines. Director Hickman - It goes to the County Auditor and they place the lien on their tax record.

Mr. Lang - How long does that usually take?

Director Hickman - For it to show up on their tax document it takes about a year because it will get sent over at end of this month and by the time they process it though it lags pretty much a year behind. **Motion passed 5-0**

Bill Spurgeon, HR Director - We've had some increased bandwidth in the legal department for legal services, we'll need your support through the end of the year. We don't believe we'll need additional monies, but what I did was error on the side of a conservative ask that if we do need additional monies you'll have some opportunity to ask some questions.

Mr. Lang - If you could just speak to where some of the additional legal services are from.

Director Spurgeon - Every three years we have contract negotiations and we're in that cycle now. We've got a couple of disparate actions in arbitration, we have an EEO challenge so we'll have to defend that we also have some turnover in departments which requires some servicing as well.

Brian Morehead, City Engineer - This is an application to ODOT to their State Infrastructure Bank for a loan in the amount of \$5 million for the Thornwood Crossing Bridge Project. We have applied to the ODOT transportation review committee and this is sort of a preemptive loan if we are not approved by TRAC we would rely on this loan, if we are approved by TRAC we may not need any of this loan or we may need a portion of it. ODOT has asked us to try to move this along as quickly as possible and they are asking for approval as quickly as possible, so that's why we asked to use Rule 11 for this. **Mr. Barker** - I just want to clarify, so this loan would be capped at \$5 million, if we need it. **Mr. Morehead** - What we don't know is if TRAC will act and approve their list of projects in December. ODOT is filing the project and getting ready to go for March bidding right now, so they need to know about the financing before that, so we're about a month and a half to two months off. **Mr. Marmie** - We will be hearing this Resolution this evening at our full council
