A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEWARK TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM THE LICKING PARK DISTRICT GOVERNMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Licking Park District administers the Government Partnership Funding Program, which administers financial assistance for public parks and recreation purposes through its grant program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Newark is eligible to apply for and invest in the long term growth and development of community parks; and,

WHEREAS, the City is eligible to apply for \$120,545.64 and provide a 50% local match of \$120,545.64; and,

WHEREAS, the Licking Park District Government Partnership Program operates on a reimbursement basis; and

WHEREAS, the City will utilize the funding for the West Canal Park Recreational Complex; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Newark does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Licking Park District Government Partnership Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1: The Newark City Council approves filing the application for financial assistance from the Licking Park District Government Partnership Program.

Section 2: Chance Patznick, Superintendent of Cemetery and Parks, local coordinator, is hereby authorized and directed to file an application with the Licking Park District and provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.

Section 3: The City of Newark does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Licking Park District Government Partnership Funding Program

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF NEWARK TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio provides financial assistance to state and local law enforcement agencies for activities which, among other purposes, improve the effectiveness of the criminal justice system; and,

WHEREAS, in Ohio, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant is administered by the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services prepared funding directives which provides that funds are available for activities to prevent and control crime, and to improve the criminal justice system; and,

WHEREAS, the local match is 25%

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, COUNTY OF LICKING, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

- Section 1: This Council does hereby authorize and direct the Mayor, and his representative, to prepare applications to the Ohio Department of Public Safety Office of Criminal Justice Services for funding assistance through the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant for Fiscal Year 2025, and to make in connection therewith, all certifications, understandings, and assurances contained therein.
- Section 2: In furtherance of the directives established herein, the Mayor is authorized to take whatever action is legally available to attain such funding in the best interest of the City and its participation in available crime prevention funding programs.
- Section 3: That the Mayor be and hereby is designated as the authorizing official to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Public Safety and its agencies to administer the grant program and to accept said funds when they become available.
- Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective upon the earliest date permitted by Article 4.07 of the Charter of the City of Newark, Ohio.


