Please allow time on your next agenda to discuss submitting legislation to Council for the following projects:

 A Resolution to submitting application for a grant and/or loan from the OPWC - State Capital Improvements Program for construction funding in 2024-2025. This resolution needs to be passed at the October 16, 2023 Council meeting to meet the application deadline.

The projects planned to take advantage of this grant and/or loan is:

Waterworks Road Bridge Repairs, over North Fork of the Licking River, SFN 4560221. The repair work is being designed now, and is estimated to extend the life of the bridge by 15-20 years, before a full replacement is required. If this grant is approved, this work will be planned to coordinate with the road closures necessary for the construction of the planned roundabout at the intersection of Waterworks Road and Horns Hill Road.
