The Capital Improvement Committee met in Council Chambers on Monday, August 31, 2015 following the Finance Committee with these members present:

We wish to Report:

1. **Resolution No. 15-79** appropriating monies for the current expenses of the municipal corporation was considered.

Section 1. A request for an appropriation of the unappropriated balance of the 335, Capital Improvement Fund, in the amount of \$34,000.00

Director Rhodes- the first \$30,000.00 will be appropriated to street paving and alley paving that will be performed by City of Newark's Street and Traffic Department. This will be in house paving. We are going to try to do as much of this each year as we can. We have the talent on staff we just don't always have the money to buy the asphalt. I am asking for \$30,000.00 to do that and then I am asking for \$4,000.00 that I am going to be putting into the City's Parks Department. We have come to an agreement with the Licking County Park District. They passed a levy maybe two years ago on bike trails. In Mr. Guthrie's committee I will be talking about that. We have a good agreement and partnership with them, they are matching our dollars to make improvements to our bike trails.

Mr. Rath- with \$30,000.00 how much paving can you do and what is the proportion of road versus alley?

Director Rhodes- there is two alleys but I am not going to be able to give you the lengths because they have been completely measured out and there are a couple of roadways, one off of 30th Street that you and I talked about four years ago. Then up in Countryside Subdivision off of Sharon Valley Rd and then Buster has one or two other small streets.

Ms. Hall- so Mr. Rhodes they are matching that?

Director Rhodes- yes
