## Violations:

Late payment of Permit fee
Grease Trap or Interceptor cleaning report not received on time
Record of cleaning schedule at establishment not complete.
Not Cleaning Grease Trap or Interceptor after ordered by Inspector

## Enforcement Action:

Formal warning for first offense (NOV) - With Written reply within two weeks.
Violation fees:

- According to Sewer Use Ordinance up to $\$ 1000$ per day.
- Most violations will be $\$ 25.00$ per day.
