Requirements:

- 1. All food service operations and food establishments are responsible to submit to the City of Newark, Division of Water and Wastewater, every six months, a report of inspection and details on cleaning of grease interceptors or grease traps. (Form attached must be completed and signed for each maintenance event)
- 2. Reports must be submitted by September 15th for the six-month period ending August 31st and March 15th for the six-month period ending February 28, 2003. Report shall be mailed to:

- 3. Permit Fee of \$50.00 is due and payable on March 1, 2004. (See attachment)
- 4. The materials removed in cleaning shall be removed from the premises for disposal and NOT deposited in the plumbing or sewage systems.
- 5. All Grease Traps and Grease Removal Systems must be operated in compliance with the City of Newark Fats, Oil and Grease Ordinance. (#03-XX)
- 6. Compliance with the City of Newark Sewer Use Ordinance is required. (#98-48)
- 7. This permit shall expire on February 28, 2006.
- 8. An authorized representative of the permittee must sign each maintenance form.
- 9. Each permittee shall follow the general guidelines described in the Best Management Practices Fact Sheet. (See Attachment "B" (#03-XX)
